Memorandum of Understanding between the Magnolia School District and the Magnolia Educators Association July 2, 2014

To ensure that there will be no negative impact to revenue received by the District under the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) with respect to Class Size Reduction (CSR), the Magnolia School District and Magnolia Educators Association (MEA) agree:

That grades 1-3 class sizes will not exceed the school-wide grades 1-3 average of the following as long as it produces no negative impact to the District's unrestricted General Fund for the length of this MOU:

- 30 students in 2013-14
- 27 students in 2014-15
- 26 students in 2015-16 and 2016-17
- 25 students in 2017-18 and 2018-19
- 24 students in 2019-20
- No class will be no more than one student above the class average for that school year


That TK-K class sizes will not exceed the school-wide TK-K average of the following as long as it produces no negative impact to the District's unrestricted General Fund for the length of this MOU:

- 30 students in 2013-14
- 26 students in 2014-15
- 25 students in 2015-16 and 2016-17
- 24 students in 2017-18
- No class will be no more than one student above the class average for that school year


If the LCFF CSR funding is not fully funded, TK-3 class sizes will revert to the current collective bargaining agreement.

This MOU will expire on June 30, 2021 or upon LCFF CSR not being fully funded, whichever is earlier.
